Theodora A. Hubert, 89, of St. Anne, died Tuesday (April 29, 2008) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, following an extended illness. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home, St. Anne, and from 9 a.m. Friday at the First Presbyterian Church in St. Anne, until the 10 a.m. services. Burial will be in St. Anne Township Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the Mooseheart Lodge or to the donor's choice. Theodora was born Aug. 29, 1918, in Momence, the daughter of Theodore and Gail Wilson. She received her teaching degree from Normal University in 1937. She worked at Papineau School as a teacher and principal. She later worked as a teacher at St. Anne Grade School. In addition to teaching, she also helped her husband farm in rural St. Anne, before retiring to Florida. Her husband, Donald Hubert, died April 6, 1974, after 35 years of marriage. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of St. Anne, the Royal Neighbors and had just received her 35-year pin with the Loyal Order of the Moose. Theodora was a loving wife, mother, grandmother and friend. She enjoyed reading, socializing, and being with her family. She was well versed in current events, and also took an interest in local and family history. She enjoyed bowling, gardening, and could frequently be found playing bingo. She enjoyed traveling, going overseas several times. She had a fantastic memory, often amazing people with her ability to recall people, places, and events. She was a wonderful person, loved by many, and will be sadly missed. She is survived by her sons, Bill (Sue) Hubert of Aroma
