Theodore "Ted" Themer, 51, of St. Anne, died Tuesday (Nov. 6, 2012) at the University of Chicago Hospital. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday, and from 9 a.m. Saturday until the 10 a.m. funeral service at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home, St. Anne. The Rev. Joe Hughes will officiate.
