Theresa Claire Burgard, age 54, died Friday, July 8, 2011 at her home in Kankakee, Illinois. The cause of death was small cell lung cancer. She was born May 27, 1957 in Ann Arbor, Michigan, the daughter of Roselyn Bertha Becker and William Charles Burgard.

Theresa graduated from Ypsilanti High School, where she was an outstanding student and athlete. She received her BS from Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, and an MS in Communication Disorders from University of Illinois, Champaign. She worked as a speech language pathologist and coached high school track in Kankakee District 111. In 2010, she was inducted into the High School Hall of Fame in honor of her 28 years of coaching. She actively supported her track girls in pursuing scholarships to college. She volunteered with the Special Olympics for a number of years. Theresa was an avid golfer and runner, finishing more than 26 marathons.

Throughout her life Theresa had a deep connection with God, and this enriched her relationships with her family and friends and her partner Jean. She had an extraordinary gift for friendship. She took on challenges and strived for excellence, living everyday with a positive attitude. She served

many and valued inclusion of all people in her work, community, and church.

Surviving are her partner of 15 years, Jean Lowery of Kankakee; her mother, Roselyn Burgard of Ypsilanti, MI; her father and his wife, William & Carole Burgard of Greenwood, SC; sister Nan Godwin and husband Christopher; brother William Burgard, wife Tracey and son Ethan; sister Lilly Crowheart, husband Kirk Houser, and son Aurelio Crowheart; brother Peter Burgard, wife Tzipora Eden, and daughters Morgan, Maya, and Corine; brother Phillip Burgard, wife Judy and daughter Bridget who is also Theresa's godchild.
