Theresa M. Blanchette Gregoire, age 93, of Bourbonnais, passed away Thursday, April 23, 2020 at Heritage Health in Dwight.

She was born December 6, 1926 in St. George, the daughter of Armand & Ida Clark Blanchette.

Theresa married Eugene Gregoire on August 11, 1945 in St. George. He preceded her in death on December 16, 2001.

She was a homemaker and had also worked at St. Joseph Church in Manteno. She was an Avon Representative for 20 years. Theresa also had worked for Marriott. She was a member of Women of the Moose. Theresa enjoyed gardening, cooking, and babysitting. She loved spending time with her children and great-grandchildren.

In younger years, Theresa was very involved in her church activities. She started the first Country Store at the St. George Homecoming (church picnic).

She had been a member of the Ladies of Sodality of Manteno.

Theresa was a parishioner of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley and a member of the CCW. She was a former CCW Woman of the Year (1967). She held the position of president, secretary, and treasurer of that organization over the years.
