Therese Lynne Grace, 65, passed away on Saturday, April 18, 2026, in Sun City West, AZ.

She was born on September 14, 1960, at St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee to Louis and Carol (Jensen) Jamnik. Therese married the love of her life, Robert Grace, on May 30, 1981, at St. Joseph Catholic Church. Together they built a life rooted in love and family as longtime residents of Bradley and Bourbonnais before relocating to Sun City West in 2022.

Therese was a proud graduate of St. Joseph Grade School and Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School. She and Robert were blessed with three beloved sons, who were the center of her world.

Therese held many jobs in her professional life. She worked as a hairdresser, pharmacy technician, and teacher's aide/library clerk at Bradley Elementary School. 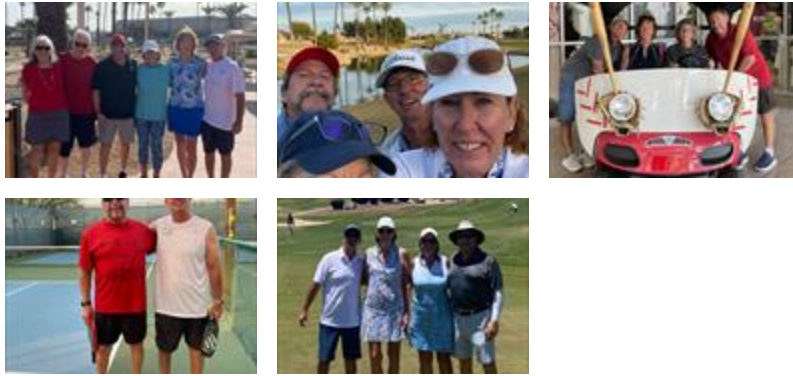

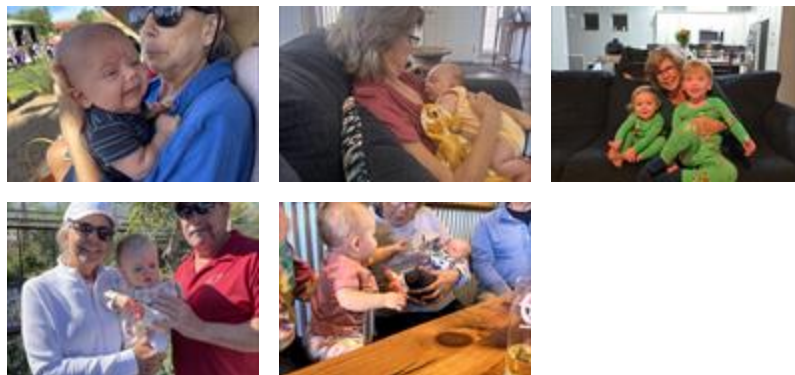

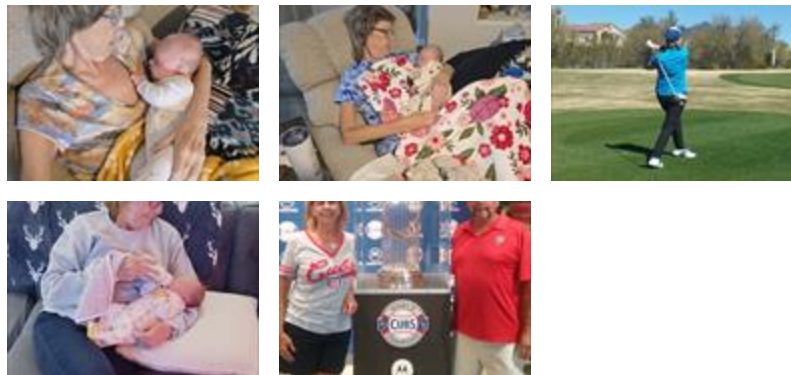
