Mr. Allison was retired from A.O. Smith. He was born Aug. 8, 1930, in Kankakee, the son of Lawrence and Nellie Lynch Allison. His wife, the former Mary Helen Jones, whom he married Aug. 9, 1957, died Feb. 26, 2008. He was a 1949 graduate of Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School. He served in the U.S. Marines during the Korean War from 1952 to 1954. He was a rock hound, member of Kankakee County Rock & Gem Club, and a groundskeeper and manager of the bait shop at Lake Chippewa Campgrounds in Heyward, Wis. He loved square dancing, fishing and camping.

Surviving are three sons and one daughter-in-law, Stephen and Mary Ann Allison, of Bradley, Thomas Marvel and Larry Marvel; five daughters and one son-in-law, Connie and Ron Page, of Evansville, Ind., Lynda Allison, of San Diego, Calif., Kathy Davis, of Florida, Beverly Blackstone, of Eau Claire, Wis.,

and Brenda Regas, of Bradley; 11 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren; and one brother and sister-in-law, Jim and Betty Allison, of Bradley.

He was preceded in death by one grandson, Thomas Gifford; his parents; and two brothers, David and Raymond Allison.
