



Thomas R. Boudreau

March 23, 1936 - September 19, 2015

Thomas R. Boudreau, 79, of Bradley, passed away Saturday (Sept. 19, 2015) at his home.

Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m.

Wednesday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais, with the Rev. Richard Pighini officiating. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery in Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made for Masses or to the family wishes.

Mr. Boudreau was ordained a permanent deacon on May 4, 1979, and was the first permanent deacon to serve at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Bradley. He also worked for General Foods Corp. for more than 30 years. He was born March 23, 1936, in Bourbonnais, the son of Eugene and Anna (Lambert) Boudreau. Thomas was a 1955 graduate of St. Pat's High School in Kankakee. Mr. Boudreau served our country for two years in the U.S. Army. The most important things in his life were his faith and his family.
