Thomas R. "Tom" Phelan, 56, of Kankakee, died Wednesday (Nov. 23, 2005) at his home. Visitation will be from noon-4 p.m. Sunday at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where services will be held at 10 a.m. Monday. Rev. Allen Dace will officiate.
