Thomas E. Renchen, age 67, of Manteno passed away Monday, August 12, 2019. He was born on March 31, 1952 in Kankakee, the son of Frank Jr. & Vera B. (Bowman) Renchen. Thomas married Joyce Bisselle on December 16, 1977 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Manteno.

Thomas grew up on a farm where he learned his many talents of being able to fix many things from watching his Grandfather. Thomas graduated from Manteno High School as the Salutatorian and received his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Illinois State University. After his father passed away in 1975, Thomas ran the operations of Sunny Acres Mobile Home Park for over twenty five years.

Thomas was interested in genealogy, and he enjoyed flying planes. He liked going to car shows and had an affinity for antique Jeeps to hunt for parts for his 1948 Willy's Jeep that he was in the process of restoring. He supported different organizations, but was significantly involved with the American Cancer Society – Relay For Life and Alzheimer's Association. Most of all, he enjoyed spending time with his family.

Thomas was a former member and past President of the Manteno Chamber of Commerce and a lifetime member of the Manteno Sportsman's Club.

Thomas was involved in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Manteno in several ministries and was a member of Immanuel United Church of Christ in Peotone, where he taught Sunday school with his wife and served on church council as a trustee, Elder, and then Senior Elder of the church.

Surviving are his wife, Joyce Renchen of Manteno; one daughter and son-in-law, Nicole Renchen & Igal Rubinshtein of Chicago; one son & daughter-in-law, Kyle Thomas & Jennifer Renchen of Bloomington; two grandchildren, Luke and Cora Renchen; two brothers and one sister-in-law, Richard Renchen of Manteno and William & Judith Renchen of Bourbonnais; one aunt, Nedine Bowman, and life-long family friends, Karen Contois of Momence and Clifford & Sharon Hamilton of Manteno. 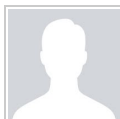
