Thomas Williams -- Kankakee Thomas Williams, 98, of Kankakee, died Monday (Oct. 17, 2005). Visitation and services will be private. Burial will be in Kankakee Memorial Gardens. Rev. Herb Thompson will officiate. Memorials may be made in his name to the donor's choice. Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, is in charge of arrangements. Mr. Williams retired in 1971 from the National Radio Astronomy Observatory in Green Bank, W.Va. He had worked at E.I. duPont and Co. in Charleston, W.Va. and in 1952, he joined Armour and Co. in Kankakee. From 1961-1963 he was an engineering consultant in West Pakistan. He was born Dec. 22, 1906, in New Castle, Pa., the son of Edwin and Jane Thomas Williams. His wife, the former Kathryn Walker, whom he married June 19, 1935, in Crafton, Pa., died Jan. 28, 1995. He was a graduate of the University of Pittsburgh with a degree in mechanical engineering and a member of the engineering honorary fraternity, Sigma Tau. Surviving are two daughters and one son-in-law, Marcia and Ronald Lemenager of St. Anne, Dianne Black of Napa, Calif.; five grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. Deceased are one daughter, Carole Williams; four brothers and four sisters.
