



Thomas "Len" Casey

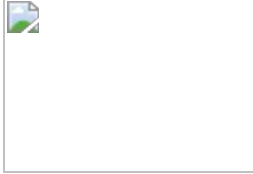
December 22, 1920 - October 23, 2009

Thomas L. "Len" Casey, 88, of Bourbonnais, died Friday (Oct. 23, 2009) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais.
