



Timothy L. Anderson

September 20, 1955 - June 24, 2018

Visitation for Timothy L. Anderson (62) will be Thursday, from 4-8 at the Clancy- Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral mass will be held Friday at St. John Paul II Parish west campus at 11a.m. with cremation rights to follow.

Tim passed away at his home on Sunday, following a short but ferocious battle with cancer. He was born on September 20th, 1955, to Duane and Veronica (Gawronski) Anderson at St. Mary's in Kankakee.

After attending St. Martin of Tours Grade School, Tim graduated from Eastridge in Kankakee in 1973. Shortly thereafter he married the love of his life, Kathy Tebo, found his calling, and joined the Local 50 Sheet Metal Workers union. He served the sheet metal industry in various roles until 1998 when he took the opportunity to purchase Thomas Baird and Sons in Kankakee, where he was employed as the HVAC estimator. This led to the formation of Anderson Mechanical Systems, which operated in Bradley serving residential and commercial customers and employed up to 30 plumbers, pipefitters, sheet metal workers, and electricians for the last 20 years.

Tim was a man of strong Catholic faith, and enjoyed giving time and money to the Knights of Columbus, of which he was a 3rd and 4th degree member; his parish; the Azzerelli Clinic; Salvation Army; and his "adopted" granddaughter in Guatemala. He also loved golfing and the outdoors, especially fishing with his grandkids. He was able to travel extensively with his wife, visiting Alaska,

Hawaii, Ireland, and most states, playing some of the finest golf courses in the world along the way. Above all he loved his family, and he went out of his way to set an example and give everything of himself. His kindness and patience were matched by no other.

Surviving are his wife, Kathy (Tebo) Anderson; one son and daughter-in-law, Lucas (Kimra) Anderson of St. Anne, three daughters and one son-in-law; Elizabeth Perzee of Bradley, Amy Anderson of Kankakee, and Allison (Thomas) Smolkovich of Herscher. Also surviving are three brothers and sisters-in-law, Steven (Sherry) Anderson of Kankakee, Jim (Andi) Anderson of Kankakee, and Robert (Amy) Anderson of Aroma Park; and one sister and brother-in-law, Susan (Mark) Colehower of Peotone; eight grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Duane and Veronica Anderson; one nephew, Danny Anderson; and one son-in-law, Douglas Perzee.

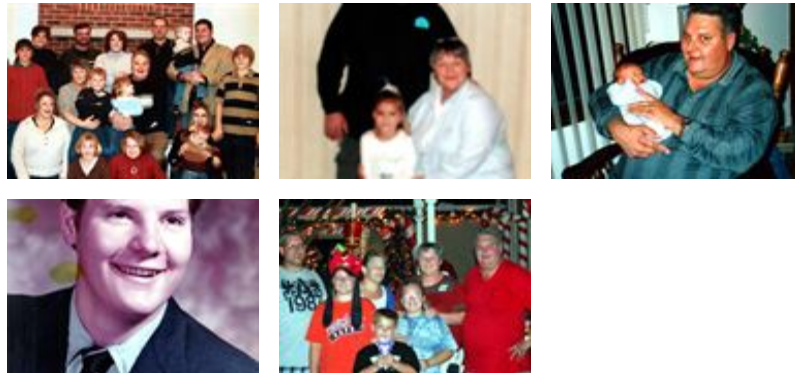
