Tina M. Grise, 69, of Kankakee, passed away on Monday, June 10, 2019 at her home. She was born on September 13, 1949 in Kankakee, the daughter of Albert and Faye Fritz Guenette. She married Richard Grise on June 7, 1969 at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church.
