Todd L. Schweizer, age 53, of Bourbonnais, passed away Monday, October 1, 2018 at Presence St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee.

He was born June 15, 1965 in Kankakee, the son of Harry & Joyce Oyler Schweizer.

In 1983, Todd graduated from Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School. He was a graduate of Illinois State University.

Todd spent more than 30 years in the field of education. For the last twenty plus years of his career, he worked for the Bradley School District.

He most recently worked for Bradley West Grade School as a special education teacher. Todd was passionate about teaching and coaching. Helping others, especially children, was one of his greatest joys. He had been an athletic director for the Bradley Lions for many years. He was a state champion high school and junior high school baseball coach.

In 2007, he earned the prestigious Illinois Principal of the Year award.

Todd was a huge fan of Chicago sports, including the Bears, White Sox, Blackhawks, and Bulls.

He enjoyed traveling, especially summer cross country baseball trips with his sons and his father-in-law. Todd enjoyed attending all sporting events.

Surviving are two sons, Mason Schweizer and Dylan Schweizer, both of

Bourbonnais; one daughter, Halle Schweizer of Bourbonnais; his former wife, Sheri Schweizer of Bourbonnais; three sisters, Rhonda & Ron Hudson of Ava, Carolynne Shear of Bourbonnais, and Rosalind & Rick Martens of Bradley; four brothers, Mitch & Cindy Schweizer of Tremont, Jeffery & Connie Schweizer of The Villages, FL, Randy & Donna Schweizer of Bourbonnais, and Monte & Donna Schweizer of Watseka; many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

He is preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Gary Schweizer; and one sister, Lana Carraher.

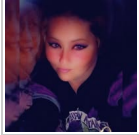

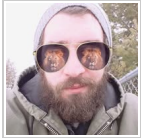

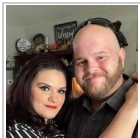
