Vada E. Beaupre, 102, of Sioux City, Iowa formerly of St. Anne, Illinois passed from this life on November 28th, 2015 after a short illness at Mercy Medical Center. Visitation will be from 9AM-11AM on Saturday, December 5th at St. Anne Catholic Church in St. Anne, with the Mass of Christian burial following the visitation. The Rev. James Finale will officiate.
