He was born Oct. 21, 1925, in Beaverville, the son of Philip and Flora Dionne Lafond. He was a trustee for the town of Beaverville for 10 years and for Iroquois Township for four years. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, Beaverville, where he was the groundskeeper for 21 years. He enjoyed baseball and farming. Surviving are his wife, the former Joann Dionne, of Watseka, whom he married March 31, 1951, at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais; three sons and daughters-in-law, Gary and Barbara Lafond of Kankakee, Todd and Connie Lafond of Mahomet, Craig and Darla Lafond of Romeoville; one daughter and son-in-law, Lesa and Robert Johnson of Bourbonnais; nine grandchildren and one great-grandchild; one sister and two brothers-in-law, Ellen May and Rex Hall of Tipton, Ind., William Reynolds of Clifton; one brother and sister-in-law, Kenneth and Virginia Lafond of Beaverville; and several nieces and nephews. Deceased are three brothers, Romain and Leonard; and one sister, Mildred Reynolds.
