Victor Pourroy, age 64, of Bradley passed away Saturday, September 4, 2021 at his home. He was born November 29, 1956 in Kankakee, the son of Jose & Verna Ruth (Allen) Pourroy. 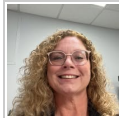
