Vincent James "Jr." D'Agostino, age 60, of Bradley, passed away on June 15, 2025.

He was born October 3, 1964 in Chicago, the son of Vito & Diana Dorman D'Agostino.

Vincent enjoyed drawing, working on cars, and drinking coffee. He worked a variety of jobs over the years. In earlier years, he liked working in his garden.

Vincent spent much of his time in the community with others. You would often see him and his bike near a lamppost.

He was of the Roman Catholic faith.

Surviving are one daughter, Amy Medina and her spouse; one sister, Debby Crum of Indiana; one brother, Dave D'Agostino of Indiana; three grandchildren; and nieces and nephews.

As per Vincent's wishes, his body has been donated to science. Private family inurnment will be held at Assumption Catholic Cemetery & Mausoleum at later date.

A memorial visitation will be held from 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. on Friday, June 27, 2025 at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home in Kankakee, with a memorial service at 4:00 p.m.

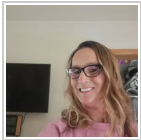

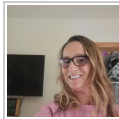
