



Wallace E. Beaver

August 6, 1923 - August 28, 2013

Wallace E. Beaver, 90, of St. Anne, passed away Wednesday (Aug. 28, 2013) at his home. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home, St. Anne, where funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday. Burial will be in St. Anne Township Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the donor's choice.

Mr. Beaver retired in 1984 from the A.O. Smith Corp. after 30 years of service. He was also a farmer. He was born Aug. 6, 1923, in Huntington, Ind., the son of Roscoe and Dorothy Kuester Beaver. His wife, the former Alvera M. Sirois, whom he married April 4, 1942, in St. Anne, preceded him in death April 3, 2005. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Force, serving during World War II.
