



Wayne Boudreau

May 15, 1939 - March 1, 2018

Wayne Boudreau (aka "Pip") died March 1, 2018 at Banner Baywood Medical Center in Mesa, AZ after a short and sudden illness. He was born May 15, 1939 in Kankakee, IL to Max & Agnes Mayotte Boudreau.

Wayne attended St. Rose Grade School & St. Patrick's High School in Kankakee. He married Brenda Johnson on June 15, 1963 at St. Rose Church in Racine, WI.

Wayne worked at the Big Bear grocery store; Bear Bran hosiery factory; First Trust Bank of Kankakee and opened and managed the West Side branch. He moved to Watseka Bank (now Mainsource) in 1993. He returned to the new First Trust Bank of Illinois as manager of the West Side until he retired in September 2004.

He was active in a number of civic organizations, including the Kankakee County Board, Kankakee County Health Board, St. Rose Holy Name Society and Chicken Bar-B-Q Committee, Knights of Columbus, Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus, Kankakee County Training Center (President & board member for 40 years), Bishop McNamara Madcaps, Kankakee Jaycees, and the Exchange Club.

Wayne and Brenda maintained their main home in Bourbonnais, IL, but spent

the last 6 years of retirement in Arizona over the winter months. During retirement, he was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease and was actively involved in Parkinson's educational support groups in Arizona.

He is preceded in death by his brothers (Wilford, LeRoy, Vernon & Merle), sisters (Venita & Joleen) and his son (Keith Joseph). He is survived by his wife of 55 glorious years, Brenda, son Kevin (Toni) Boudreau of Gilbert, AZ; son Kent Boudreau of Bourbonnais, IL and grandchildren Nicole Hollenbeck (Bradley) of Cleveland, OH, Christina Boudreau of Tempe, AZ, Luke Boudreau of Mesa, AZ, Veronica Boudreau of Gilbert, AZ, Sarah Boudreau of Gilbert, AZ and Aaron Michael Joseph Boudreau of Gilbert, AZ.
