Wayne Cahan -- Bradley Wayne B. Cahan, 83, of Bradley, died Friday (Nov. 4, 2005) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Visitation will be from 2-4 p.m. today at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley, where he was a member. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery. Mr. Cahan worked in construction, and later as a school custodian, retiring from Kankakee District 111, after 18 years of service (1985). He was a member of the Bradley Bourbonnais Seniors Club. He enjoyed walking, his yard, raising flowers, wood novelties, jigsawing and traveling. Surviving are his wife, the former Daisy Frances Palermo of Bradley, whom he married June 7, 1958 at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church; one son and daughter-in-law, Steven and Vicki Cahan of Kankakee; one grandson, Tim Cahan; two stepgrandchildren; one stepgreat-grandchild; and one brother and sister-in-law, Norman and Anneliese Cahan of Bourbonnais.
