Wayne P. Doyle, of Bourbonnais, loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather, now free of pain, entered into eternal rest on Sept 19, 2016. Wayne was born December 19, 1932 of Wesley "Pat" and Aldaha Laurent Doyle in Clifton, IL. He is preceded in death by his parents, his wife (Nita) and his sister (Wanda Jensen).

He graduated from Ash-Clif High School (there were only seven graduating classes from Ash-Clif) and went to Bradley University in Peoria for two years. Wayne met the love of his life, Nita, and they were married on July 30th, 1953, on a seven day furlow from the Army. They had one week together and he then left for Korea. He was discharged on December 23, 1954. While in the Army he earned the rank of staff sergeant and received various medals, including the Medal of Merit, and expert rifleman. He retired from Quaker Oats, formerly General Foods, where he was sent to Caracas, Venezuela four times to solve various engineering problems. During his tenure at General Foods, he received the Gaines Founder's Award for developing a solution to a long-standing problem with Gaines former wrappers.

He was one of two people who designed Exline Sportsman's Club. He also designed two homes and contracted one of the homes he lived in.

He was the loving husband of (Juanita) Nita Hester for 60 years before her

passing in 2014. They were blessed with three children. Two daughters and son-in-laws, Debra (Jonathan) Weidner of Spring, Texas, Lisa (Larry) Jose of Southfield, Michigan, one son, Michael, of Bartlett, Illinois. He was proud of his three children, thirteen grandchildren, Rebecca Garvin, Carol Vasek Bienz, Chris (Katie) Bott, Nathaniel (Sarah), Timothy, Jessica, Joel, Joseph, Sarah, Jeremy, Joshua, Stephen, and Rachel Weidner. He also enjoyed his four great-grandchildren – Brandon, Breanna, Kyleigh and Kyleb Vasek.

In winters they vacationed in Tavares, FL, where they had many friends and were very active.
