William F. Hatting, 86, of Kankakee, died Wednesday (Sept. 15, 2010) at the Miller Center. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in ourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Monday at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee, where he was a member. The Rev. John Peeters will officiate. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens of Memory. Mr. Hatting retired from the Illinois Department of Transportation after 30 years of service. He lived in Florida for many years after his retirement, returning to the Kankakee area in 2006. He was born Oct. 14, 1923, in St. Paul, Minn., the son of Frank and Edna Schneider Hatting. His wife, the former Juanice Lehman, whom he married Aug. 17, 1952, at St. Patrick Catholic Church, died Feb. 25, 1990. He was a graduate of St. Patrick Grade School and St. Patrick High School. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and a former member of Kankakee American Legion Post 85. He was an avid Cubs fan. He loved to read and travel. He enjoyed bowling, fishing and spending time with his family and friends. He was known for his generosity and supported many charitable organizations. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Thomas and Alice Hatting, of Wheaton, Richard and Jeanne Hatting, of Kankakee; three grandchildren, Matthew Hatting, Elizabeth Hatting and Andrew Hatting; one sister, Phyllis Mansfield of Springfield; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and two sisters, Betty Brighton and Janice Ziemer.
