William Potter -- Kankakee William C. Potter, 82, of Kankakee, died Saturday (Sept. 10, 2005) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Graveside services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at Mound Grove Gardens. Pastor Dave Reynolds will officiate. Memorials may be made to the Kankakee County Humane Society, Provena St. Mary's Foundation or to Trinity United Methodist Church, where he was a member. Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements. Mr. Potter retired from Commonwealth Edison after 42 years of service. He was born July 6, 1923, in Kankakee, the son of William C. and Esther Lindgren Potter. His wife, the former Shirley Smith, whom he married in May 1948 at Trinity United Methodist Church, died in February 1994. He was a first lieutenant in the U.S. Army serving during World War II and the Korean conflict. He was a member of Kankakee American Legion Post 85. He loved animals; gardening, especially geraniums; growing orchids indoors; and home improvement projects, including building models. Surviving are one daughter, Jan Potter and her fiance, Paul Reed of Kankakee.
