Mr. Etzel worked for Conrail for 25 years, retiring in 1982. He then worked for Kankakee Public Works Department. He was born Sept. 28, 1931, in Kankakee, the son of Wynn and Ina Landrie Etzel. His wife, the former Edith Lord, whom he married Jan. 21, 1950, in Kankakee, died Sept. 26, 2010. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army National Guard, serving during the Korean conflict. He enjoyed woodworking, meeting at Jaffe Drug Store in Bradley for coffee with his friends, and being with his family.

Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, William and Lucy Etzel, of Bourbonnais; four daughters and three sons-in-law, Nora and Dan Patchett, of St. Anne, Laura Lea Etzel and Joan and James Lemner, all of Bradley, and Jean and Brian Kennell, of Lindenhurst; 14 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; stepfather, Clifford Lord; and one brother, Richard.
