



## Yvonne Kay "Bunny" Flynn

April 10, 1936 - October 20, 2018

Yvonne Kay "Bunny" Flynn, age 82, of Grant Park passed away Saturday, October 20, 2018 at Miller Health Care in Kankakee. She was born April 10, 1936 in Joliet, the daughter of John & Hazel (Tremper) Moats. Yvonne married Donald Blasdel on August 26, 1952. He preceded her in death in December of 1955. She then married Harold C. Flynn on June 1, 1957. He preceded her in death on October 11, 2000.

Yvonne started her work career in 1953 as a long-distance telephone operator for the Illinois Bell Telephone Company in Joliet. She was also employed by Kankakee County Court House in the office of Herbert Hess, Clerk of the Circuit Court, and office clerk and court reporter for the Magistrates. Yvonne also worked as a traffic manager at Agar Packing Company in Momence and Bluebird Packing Company in South Holland for ten years. Later, she worked at Chicago Natural Foods in South Holland as a bookkeeper/secretary for five years. She ended her career after working for 30 years at E & E Custom Products, Inc. in Grant Park as a bookkeeper and secretary. She retired after the business was sold.

Bunny enjoyed camping, snowmobiling, and boating. She was an avid reader. Bunny and her husband, Harold, were members of the Spring Valley Boat Club. She was a huge Green Bay Packer fan and was proud to be a shareholder. Bunny cherished the time spent with her children and grandchildren.

Bunny was of the Catholic faith and was a parishioner of St. George Catholic

Church in Bourbonnais.
