Yvonne Piggush -- Bourbonnais Yvonne P. Piggush, 91, of Bourbonnais, died Thursday (July 19, 2007) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, after a short illness, two weeks short of celebrating her 66th wedding anniversary with her husband. She was a member of the Ladies of St. Anne, the Retired Teacher's Association, the Bradley-Bourbonnais Senior Citizens, and the Kankakee Senior Citizens. She enjoyed walking with her kind, loving husband, Henry. She also loved mingling and conversing with people and attending family functions. Yvonne was a wonderful role model, mother, and grandmother for her six children, 13 grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren. Surviving are her husband, Henry H.
